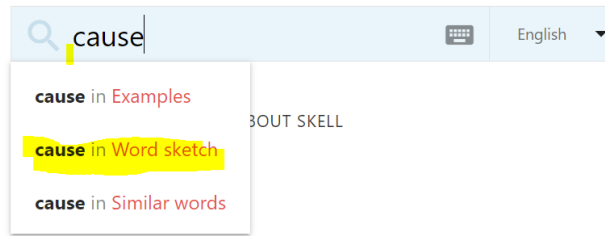
## Practice

### 1) Let's try a collocation search using SKELL



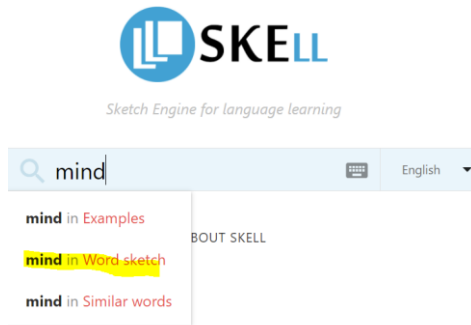
*Sketch Engine for language learning*

  - b. Go to word sketch
  - c. Look at **object of cause**
  - d. Look at the words connected to cause and answer the question

## 2) Let's try a collocation search using SKELL.

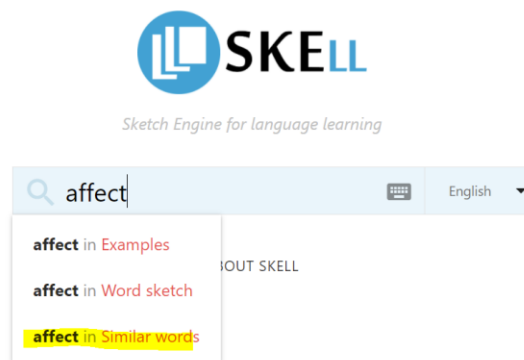


- Type the word **mind** in the search bar.

affect    verb ▾

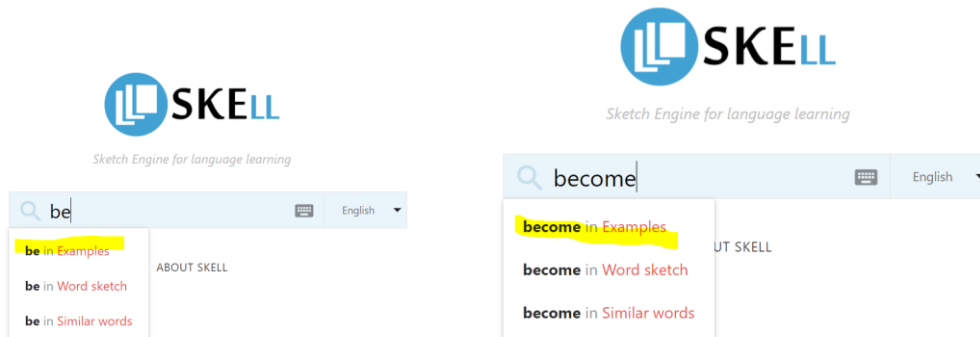
- Make sure to **select affect** as a **verb**
